CHRISTMAS CONFESSIONS. Time is passing quickly! Please take advantage soon of the extra opportunities to avail yourselves of the Sacrament of Holy Confession. All parishioners should be planning to go to Confession in preparation for the Feast of the Nativity of Christ. Please do not wait until the last minute to take care of this important spiritual matter. Christmas will be here before you know it, and the Confession lines will only get longer. The *best time* for Confession is still **BEFORE & AFTER Saturday** evening Vespers. Confessions for the elderly, for the infirm and for those who live at a great distance from the church can be arranged for Sundays. When the deacon door is OPEN, Father is available for Confession. Confessions can also be heard *before and after* scheduled weekday services. However, if you want to come *before* a service, please call Father and let him know your intentions. If you really can't make it to Confession at the regularly scheduled times, please call for an appointment.

Please sign-up on the sheet on the bulletin board if you want to have vigil lights burn during the week. These candles are contained in glass receptacles with covered tops, and are much safer.
